Thank you for your interest in the TRIO Student Support Services Program at University of Detroit Mercy. Please review our eligibility information below.

Eligibility Information

To qualify for TRIO Student Support Services at University of Detroit Mercy applicants MUST be:

- x Currently enrolled or accepted for enrollment at University of Detroit Mercy as an undergraduate student.
- x Be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident as defined by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services

In addition, those who satisfy the above conditions MUST ALSO meet at least ONE of the following eligibility criteria:

- ‘ First-generation college student
- ‘ Income eligible
- ‘ Student with a documented disability

TRIO Student Support Services is a competitive program. If the program roster is full, student applicants will be placed on a waiting list and admitted when participant numbers permit. All services are provided at no cost to participants.

Application Process (Completion Time: Approx. 15 mins)

Submit a completed application packet. You will need to complete all sections of the application including the demographic and eligibility information, academic success obstacle self-assessment, and short written response explaining how you expect TRIO SSS to support/enhance your academic and collegiate experience. Our office will contact you with any additional verification forms we may need.

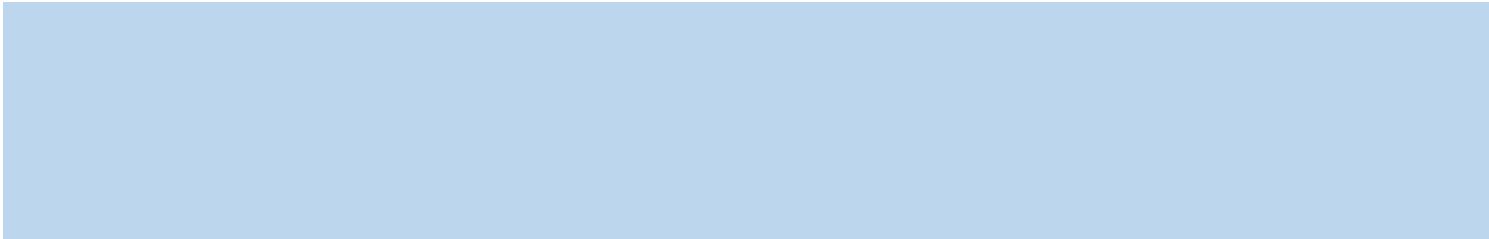
